

Banner Care

VERY IMPORTANT

- 1 - DO NOT let the ink surfaces touch** as they may stick together.
- 2 - Do NOT fold or crease your banner.** Rolling for storage will allow it to look much better when reopened.
- 3 - Store your banner back in the box it came in or a similar box for storage. ROLL your banner FACE-OUT during storage.
- 4 - Do NOT put tape or other sticky materials on the ink surface. It may damage the print.
- 5 - Do NOT use caustic agents or solvents on your banner. Window cleaner or soapy water work fine.
- 6 - We do not recommend hanging a vinyl banner on a fence due to the limited life on a fence because of wind stress. We recommend our Mesh Fence Banner for fence lines, or on buildings. However, if you do hang a vinyl banner on a fence, or on a building, be sure it is tied as tight as possible to reduce flapping from wind stress.

Hanging Your Mesh Fence Banner On Your Fence Line

Be sure your banner is hung taut so it does not flap in the wind. This is VERY IMPORTANT as flapping in the wind can destroy them quickly. Be 100% SURE to use ALL the grommet holes and tie them tightly to the fence with the provided nylon strapping ties.
